REPUBLIC DAY ASSEMBLY

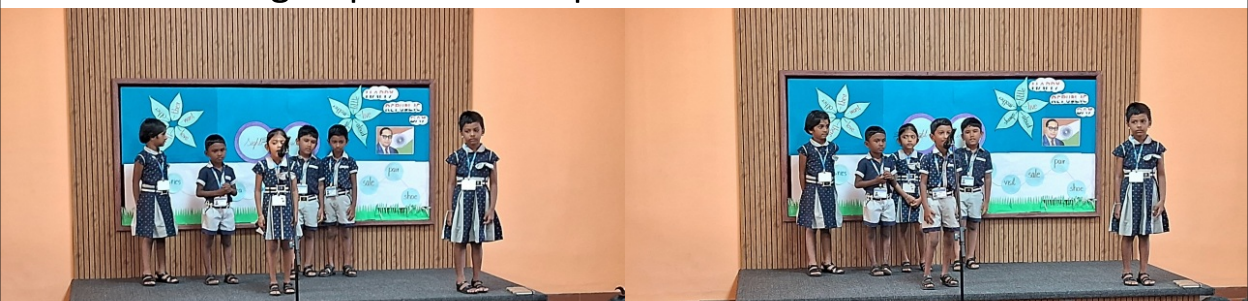
